Purpose of processing and legal basis - Art.13 co.1 lett.c)

The Data Controller processes the personal data you have communicated in the performance of tasks of relevant public interest - pursuant to Art. 6 co.1 lett. e) of the GDPR and Art. 2 sexies lett.bb) of Legislative Decree no. 196/2003 as amended by Legislative Decree no. 101/2018, and in particular:

- for the participation to the initiatives proposed by Informambiente office within the Project LIFE Veneto ADAPT (LIFE16-CCAIT000090);
